

Driver's Instruction Permit

How To Obtain

A Driver's Instruction Permit can be obtained, in person, at the Isanti County Auditor-Treasurer office.

Submit a valid test score sheet and proof of identity, or current permit. If replacing a lost or stolen permit, proof of identity must be presented. A vision test will be given. Applicants under 18 years of age must have the application signed by a parent or guardian, or notarized.

Note: The Isanti County Auditor-Treasurer office does NOT offer written or "behind-the-wheel" driver's license testing. See the Minnesota Department of Vehicle Services Web site for testing locations.

Required Forms

The Driver's Instruction Permit application form is available at the Isanti County Auditor-Treasurer office.

First-time applicants must have a valid test score sheet.

Required Identification

Required Fees

Driver's Instruction Permit - \$12.00

The Isanti County Auditor-Treasurer office can only accept payment by cash or check.
