

**REGULAR MEETING OF THE ISANTI COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

o0o Vice Chairperson Daudt convened the meeting and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

08/11-28 Motion by Southerland, seconded by Morris to approve the agenda with an addition regarding cleanup along Lake Francis. Motion carried.

08/11-29 Motion by Morris, seconded by Southerland to approve the minutes of the November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2008 County Board meeting. Motion carried.

08/11-30 Motion by Southerland, seconded by Morris to approve a permit to conduct off-site gambling to the Isanti County Sportsman Club for a raffle to be held on January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2009 at Captains on Long Lake, located in Bradford Township, Isanti County. Motion carried.

o0o Mike Ammend, Sheriff, presented a request to purchase a new County squad car to replace a totaled out vehicle.

08/11-31 Motion by Morris, seconded by Pagel to authorize the sheriff's department to purchase a new squad car to replace totaled out vehicle. Motion carried.

08/11-32 Motion by Pagel, seconded by Morris to set the year end County Board Meeting for Monday, December 29<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. Motion carried.

08/11-33 Motion by Southerland, seconded by Morris to bid out the 2009 Miscellaneous Public Defender Contract for 2009. Motion carried.

08/11-34 Motion by Southerland, seconded by Morris to approve the following utility permits: to CenterPoint Energy for a gas valve repair, along CSAH #5 and a natural gas service along and across CSAH #5. Motion carried.

08/11-35 Motion by Morris, seconded by Southerland to approve the final contract voucher #0803 in the amount of \$38,757.43 to Knife River. Motion carried.

08/11-36 Motion by Pagel, seconded by Southerland to approve final contract voucher #0804 in the amount of \$2,250.35 to Knife River. Motion carried.

o0o Jim Rostberg indicated to the Board that he had applied for a grant from the MN Department of Veteran's Affairs to fund a full time position in his department and has received \$21,500. Jim noted that this employee is now working 3 days per week and these funds would pay the difference and would be of no extra cost to the County. Jim further noted that this is a 1 year temporary grant and he will need to apply again next year for 2010, and also stated that if the grant is not renewed, this employee would go back to 3 days per week.

08/11-37 Motion by Morris, seconded by Southerland to authorize the Veteran's Service 3/5 time employee move to full time, using grant monies applied and received by the Veteran's Service Office. Southerland withdrew his second, Pagel than seconded motion. Voting Yes: Morris. Voting No: Pagel, Southerland. Motion failed.

08/11-38 Motion by Southerland, seconded by Pagel to send this request made by Jim Rostberg, Veteran's Service Officer to the Personnel Committee. Motion carried.

o0o At this time a Public Hearing was held to consider a Petition to Form the Lake Francis Lake Improvement District. Coordinator Tvedt read the following published public notice: ISANTI COUNTY BOARD NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PETITION TO FORM THE LAKE FRANCIS LAKE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Isanti County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 103B.521, Subd. 2, on Wednesday, November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at 9:30 a.m. in the County Board Room of the Isanti County Government Center, 555 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW, Cambridge, MN 55008, to consider the petition to form the Lake Francis Improvement District (Isanti County). The statute requires the Isanti County Board to determine whether the proposed lake improvement district should be established. The petition states the lake improvement district will benefit property owners with a cleaner lake that will provide better recreation for those who own property and use the lake. The lake improvement district will include all properties that abut Lake Francis. The establishment of the proposed lake improvement district requires review by the commissioner of natural resources and the approval of the Isanti County Board. Concerned citizens may submit evidence at a public hearing to be held prior to passage of any resolution establishing the proposed lake improvement district. Concerned citizens may also submit evidence and opinions to the commissioner of natural resources. A copy of the petition for the establishment of the lake improvement district is available for public review at the Isanti County Coordinator's Office in the Isanti County Government Center, 555 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW, Cambridge, MN 55008 or by telephone at 763-689-3859. Interested citizens are encouraged to attend the public hearing and to express their views regarding this petition. Those persons who are unable to attend the public hearing may express their views in writing to: Jerry T Tvedt, Isanti County Coordinator, 555 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW, Cambridge MN 55008. Coordinator Tvedt indicated he had received a letter from Alex Kolisnyk requested that his name be removed from the petition; further indicating that he had received a letter from Bradford Twp indicating they support the petition to create a Lake Francis Improvement District. Coordinator Tvedt received a letter from Al and Jan Grinde in which was read into the record; further Coordinator Tvedt indicated that he had received a letter from the Department of Natural Resources in which they approve the proposed boundaries identified in the petition, however the DNR recommends the Board of Commissioners limit the authority of the LID to matters that can be addressed by the riparian property owners, such as drawdowns and other in-lake studies and activities. Jeffrey Edblad, County Attorney indicated to the Board that there are 113 property owners and the petition needs to be signed by 50% of those property owners, and at 8:30 this morning he was informed that there were 3 different petitions that were circulated for signatures. Petition "A" does meet the statutory requirements of MS 103B.521; however Petition "B" and Petition "C" do not. Edblad noted that petition "A" that meets the statutory requirements has 34 signatures on it which does not represent the majority, and recommends to the County Board not to hold a public hearing as they do not have legal authority. Edblad indicated that the matter will have to go back to the property owners for a new petition.

o0o There was a brief discussion on possible cleanup of a Lake Francis property which was sold at the Tax Forfeited Land Sale.

08/11-42 Motion by Morris, seconded by Southerland to approve the following Planning Commission Action: the request of Earle Stoeckel Estate for a preliminary plat of Stoeckel Farm (legal desc: NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 except the South 655' of the East 654' of said NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec 22, Twp 34, Rg 25, Stanford Twp). Motion carried.

o0o Jackie Forner, Transit Director presented a request to purchase a Mohawk Lift, one man lift and wash bay curtain, with the local match funding of \$9641.88 (20%).

08/11-43 Motion by Morris, seconded by Southerland to authorize the Transit Department to purchase a Mohawk Lift, one man lift and wash bay curtain with local match funding of \$9641.88. Motion carried.

o0o Jackie Forner, Transit Director presented a request to approve a flat fee for vehicle labor. Forner indicated that they would like to set oil changes at \$25; \$70 for diesel; and a labor fee at \$50 per hour.

08/11-44 Motion by Morris, seconded by Southerland to approve the following fees for transit mechanical services: \$25 for oil change; \$70 for diesel; and a labor fee of \$50 per hour. Motion carried.

o0o Chad Struss, Auditor's Accountant presented a request to amend the County's Credit Card Policy regarding fuel cards only.

08/11-45 Motion by Morris, seconded by Southerland to amend Isanti County's Credit Card Policy as follows: to authorize the Auditor-Treasurer department to obtain fuel cards for the Assessor, Building Maintenance, Parks, Public Health, Zoning and Probation departments. Motion carried.

o0o Barry Wendorf, Parks Director presented an authorization to pay Isanti County Soil and Water Conservation District for 10.8 acres of prairie seeding in the amount of \$5335. Wendorf indicated that reimbursement in the amount of \$4001.25 will come from the state "Native Buffers Program" Grant, with the final cost to the county being \$1333.75.

o0o Kevin VanHooser, Family Services Director, presented his agency's financial report to the Board.
