o0o Tim Marion, MN DNR appeared before the Board to discuss the proposed acquisition of the following properties for water, forestry, wildlife, and natural plant community conservation purposes: Clifford Edblad, Loren Lindberg, Mark Melius, and Gerald Eggert lands in Sec 15, 16 and 22 of Twp 35N, Range 25W, Spencer Brook Twp.

10/07-38 Motion by Larson, seconded by Southerland to approve the following ISANTI COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REVIEW OF PROPOSED STATE LAND ACQUISITION. In accordance with Minnesota Statutes 97A.145, Subd. 2, the Commissioner of the Department of Natural

Resources on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010 provided the County Board with a description of lands to be acquired by the State of Minnesota for water, forestry, wildlife, and natural plant community conservation purposes. Lands to be acquired are described as follows: Clifford Edblad, Loren Lindberg, Mark Melius, and Gerald Eggert lands in Section 15, 16 and 22 of Twp 35N Range 25W, Spencer Brook Township, Isanti County - 234.44 acres. IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Isanti County on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010 that the State's proposed acquisition of the attached described property be approved. Motion carried unanimously.

10/07-42 Motion by Southerland, seconded by Duff to approve motion #10/07-39 as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

10/07-43 Motion by Southerland, seconded by Duff to approve a utility permit to East Central Energy for a buried electric service, across CR #37. Motion carried unanimously.

10/07-44 Motion by Larson, seconded by Southerland to approve the following Isanti County Resolution No. 10-13-07, Striping of Isanti and Kanabec County Roads SP 088-070-018. WHEREAS, Isanti and Kanabec County's jointly applied for and were approved for federal funding for the striping of county roads, and WHEREAS, Kanabec County has received and opened bids for this work, and NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLED, that the Isanti County Board of Commissioners recommend the award of said work to AAA Striping Services in the amount of \$381,205.83, contingent upon Kanabec County and the Minnesota Department of Transportation awarding of said work, and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Isanti County agrees to pay for the non-participating costs on the Isanti County Road System. Motion carried unanimously.

10/07-46 Motion by Duff, seconded by Southerland to approve payment to East Central Sanitation in the amount of \$4200 for materials recycled and marketed; said monies to come from SCORE. Motion carried unanimously.

10/07-47 Motion by Southerland, seconded by Daudt to approve payment of \$500 to Stanchfield Twp for reimbursement of their 2010 annual township cleanup. Motion carried unanimously.

10/07-48 Motion by Daudt, seconded by Southerland to approve the following Planning Commission Action: the request of Hardrives, Inc and Ken Olson and Richard Olson for a conditional use permit for a temporary construction facility (asphalt plant). (Legal Desc: NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec 1, Twp 35, Rg 23, Isanti Township with the following conditions: 1. Approved per the submitted site plan, 2. The start date will be July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010 and the end date will be the 2010 construction season (approximately around Thanksgiving)

and that they have 30 days after the 2010 construction season to clean up the site, 3. The hours of operation will be Monday thru Saturday, 6:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.; with no Sunday operations, 4. The applicant conforms to the dust control as stated in his plan, 5. The noise control as stated in their plan, 6. Must get the required permits, 7. Follow the reclamation plan, 8. Meet conditions set forth by the Isanti County Highway Engineer regarding any damage to the stretch of roadway be repaired by the contractor, at no cost to the County and to the satisfaction of the Isanti County Highway Department and that no hauling operations occur on CSAH 19A south of this entrance; based on the following Findings: That the conditional use permit will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purpose already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the immediate vicinity due to the fact that this permit will be temporary in nature, 2. That the establishment of the conditional use will not impede the normal and orderly development and improvement of surrounding vacant property for uses predominant in the area due to the fact that this permit will be temporary in nature, 3. That adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and other necessary facilities have been or are being provided the site plan addresses this, 4. That adequate measures have been or will be taken to provide sufficient off-street parking and loading space to serve the proposed use, the site plan addresses this, 5. That adequate measures have been or will be taken to prevent or control offensive odors, fumes, dust, noise, and vibration so that none of these will constitute a nuisance, and to control lighted signs and other lights in such a manner that no disturbance to neighboring properties will result, the site plan with dust and noise control and reclamation addresses this and that this is temporary in nature. Motion carried unanimously.
