00o Chairperson Anderson convened the meeting and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

00o Public Comment Session. A resident presented public comment.

15/10-24 Motion by Morris, seconded by Turnquist to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

15/10-25 Motion by Oslund, seconded by Turnquist to approve the minutes of the October 7, 2015, County Board meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

15/10-26 Motion by Morris, seconded by Oslund to approve the Joint Drainage Authority for Isanti and Mille Lacs Counties-Legal Services Agreement. Motion carried unanimously.

15/10-27 Motion by Warring, seconded by Morris to approve the 2016 East Central Regional Library's 2016 budget in the amount of \$1,860,514 with Isanti County's portion set at \$372,933. Motion carried unanimously.

00o U of M Board member Ken Schroepner introduced Jill Eck, Regional Director MN Extension; Joan Watson, Master Gardener; and Jennifer Olson, Interim 4-H Program Coordinator to the Board.

15/10-28 Motion by Morris, seconded by Warring to approve the following Resolution Supporting the Display of the National Motto "In God we Trust" in the Isanti County Board Room based on: 1. The slogan has been deemed to be a secular national slogan; 2. The slogan does not dictate anyone's personal beliefs; 3. The slogan is ceremonial in nature; 4. The slogan is patriotic in nature; 5. The slogan is a reminder of national heritage and identity: WHEREAS, "In God We Trust" became the United States national motto on July 30, 1956, shortly after our nation led the world through the trauma of World War II; and WHEREAS, the words have been used on U.S. currency since 1864; and WHEREAS, the same inspiring slogan is engraved above the entrance to the Senate Chamber as well as above the Speaker's dais in the House of Representatives; and WHEREAS, in both war and peace, these words have been a profound source of strength and guidance to many generations of Americans; and WHEREAS the County desires to display this patriotic motto in the County Board Room as a way to solemnize public occasions and express confidence in our society. NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Isanti County Board of Commissioners hereby determines that the historic and patriotic words of our national motto, "In God We Trust", shall be prominently displayed in the Board Room of the Isanti County Government Center. Motion carried unanimously.

WHEREAS; Isanti County has programmed County State Aid Highway 9 for reconstruction in 2016 from Trunk Highway 65 to County Highway 45, and WHEREAS, the reconstruction project will require permanent and temporary highway easements for the construction and future maintenance of the highway section, and WHEREAS; Isanti County has the authority to acquire the right of way for said

highway project by eminent domain pursuant to Minnesota Statute Section 163.02, Subd. 2, and WHEREAS; Isanti County has the right to acquire the right of way prior to the filing of an award by the court appointed commissioners, pursuant to Minnesota Statute 117, and WHEREAS; Isanti County has determined that eminent domain will be utilized for the right of way land acquisition when acquisition is unsuccessful through negotiations, and BE IT RESOLVED, the Isanti County Board of Commissioners authorize the acquisition of lands by eminent domain, and to take the title and possession of lands prior to the filing of an award by the court appointed commissioners, pursuant to Minnesota Statute 117, for the reconstruction of County State Aid Highway 9, S.P. 030-609-009, and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; the Isanti County Attorney is authorized to commence with the eminent domain proceedings on the parcels of land as deemed necessary by the County Attorney and County Engineer. Motion carried unanimously.
