There is natural screening already on the property so that the conditional use will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purpose already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the immediate vicinity, 2. The cell tower may increase property values and will make it safer for individuals that live in the area, 3. That the establishment of the conditional use will not impede the normal and orderly development and improvement of surrounding vacant property for uses predominant in the area, 4. There is an easement provided to access the tower so that adequate measures have been or will be taken to provide sufficient off-street parking and loading space to serve the proposed use, 5. There is sufficient natural landscaping and fencing around the tower so that adequate measures have been or will be taken to prevent or control offensive odors, fumes, dust, noise and vibration so that none of these will constitute a nuisance, and to control lighted signs and other lights in such manner that no disturbance to neighboring properties will result.
