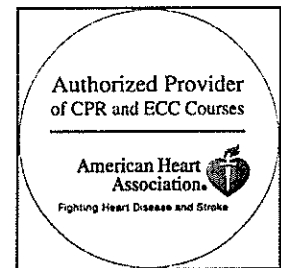

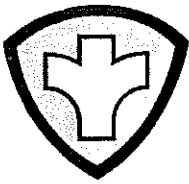

Subject: Classes for Child Care License
Re: Isanti County Public Health

This letter serves to inform you of upcoming Child Care License classes in Isanti County on 11/20/2008. Isanti County Public Health will be providing Sudden Infant Death/Shaken Baby Syndrome (SIDS/SBS) and Child Passenger Safety (CPS) as a combined class.

The objectives of the CPS, SIDS/SBS presentations are to:

1. List four types of child restraint systems
2. Explain the purpose of a booster seat
3. Select an appropriate restraint for a child in their care
4. List two child passenger safety resources
5. Recognize a correctly installed child restraint system, using appropriate reference materials.
6. Define SBS/SIDS
7. Identify signs and symptoms of SBS
8. List ways to avoid shaking a baby
9. List ways to minimize risk for SIDS
10. Know mandatory reporting procedure for SIDS/SBS

Upon completion of the CPR course you will be certified in CPR/AED from American Heart Association.

The classes are available for a fee of \$25.00/person for CPS (2hr class) and \$25.00/person for SIDS/SBS (a 2hr class.) The CPR class is available for a fee of \$25.00/person; the CPR class is 2hrs long, and requires a minimum of eight people to sign up for the class to be held.

Please call Public Health to sign up for each class. The classes may be taken individually if necessary.
