- ❖ Act as a collective voice of foster and adoptive parents affiliated with the Isanti County Family Services.

The Isanti County Foster Parent Advisory Board is a self governing group, which meets every month, alternating evenings/mornings to advocate for the things foster parents care about.

Foster Parent Advisory is open to anyone who is licensed by Isanti County Family Services for Child Foster Care. This includes relatives, concurrent providers, and/or general child foster care homes.
