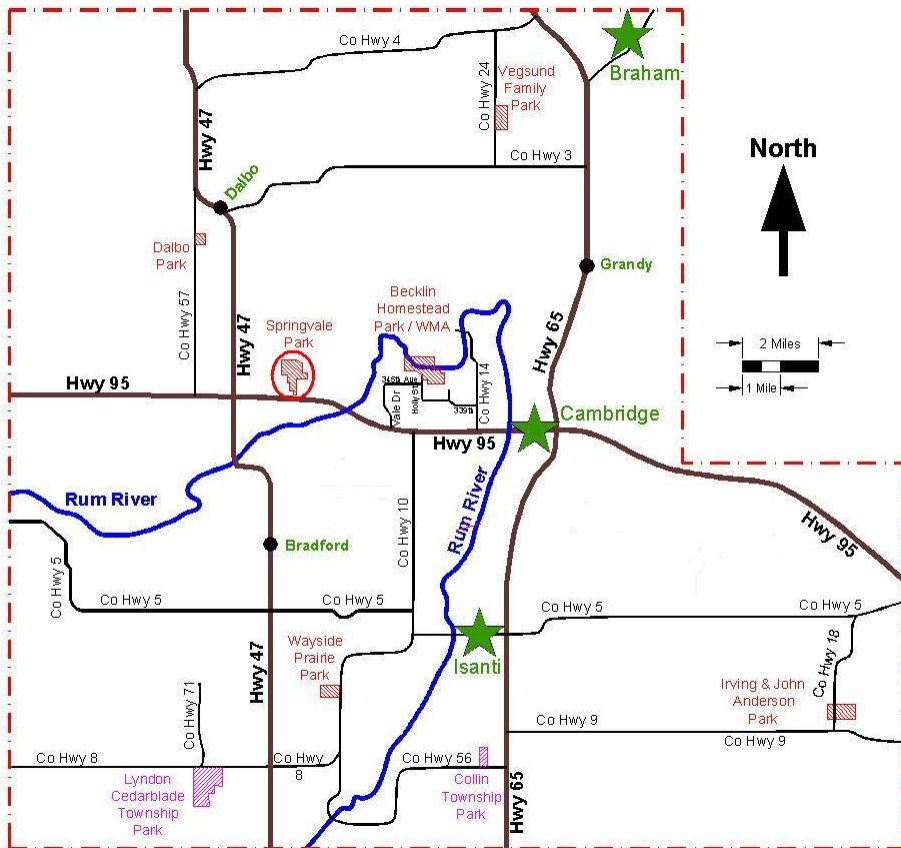


## Springvale County Park 3361 Hwy 95 NW, Cambridge MN 55008

The park is located in Springvale township on the north side of hwy 95, 7.5 miles west of Cambridge and 2 miles east of hwy 47.



## SPRINGVALE COUNTY PARK

Springvale became Isanti Counties 3<sup>rd</sup> County Park in 1995. Since that time an additional 102 acres have been purchased expanding from the original tax forfeited property. Today the 211 acre park consists of gently rolling hills, open fields, numerous wetlands, and hardwood forests, along with remnants of a spruce tree farm to the north. The soil type consists of a transition from Anoka Sand Plain (sand) into Mille Lacs Upland (clay).

## FACILITIES

Facilities currently include two trail head parking areas, Information Kiosks, picnic tables, benches, restroom and 1/4 mile of paved trail.

There are 4 miles of multi use trails open to: hiking, biking, running, horseback riding, and snowshoeing, with 4 miles of groomed cross country ski trails.
