The Isanti County Probation Office is able to offer a limited number of opportunities students to serve as unpaid interns to receive academic credit or to fulfill an academic requirement of an accredited education institution. All interns will work a minimum of 400 hours, unless otherwise approved.

Interns will be assigned and supervised by a member of the intern committee, but are encouraged to work with most, if not all, agents in the office. Training requirements will be assigned by the intern supervisor. Work responsibilities are dependent on approval from the supervising agent and/or the Probation Director.

Unpaid interns will not be entitled to wages or compensation, and they will be required to maintain strict confidentiality concerning private, confidential, or privileged information that they encounter during their internship. The internship may be terminated at any time by either the intern or the Isanti County Probation Office.
