

## **Anderson Park Master Plan Update**

The Isanti County Parks Department is preparing an updated master plan for Irving and John Anderson Park. In 2007, 174 acres were purchased by the county to create Anderson Park. In 2013, a master plan was created and approved by the County; this plan has served as a guide to improvements over the last 6 years, as well as provided a framework for designation as a Regional Park by the Greater Minnesota Parks and Trails Commission, and award of grant funding through the statewide Legacy Fund.

Recently, Isanti County purchased an additional 236 acres along Horseshoe and Horseleg Lakes, including the Fox Farm, Keen Farm, and Hanon Farm (See map below). This additional parkland provides new opportunities for future recreation, lake access, interpretive or educational features, native and ecological restoration and additional trail connections throughout the park.

The master plan update will be created over the spring, summer, and fall of 2019, and will include gathering broad public input from the community, to inform the master plan and future recommendations. Many perspectives will be considered on important issues that will affect recreational uses and ecological restoration of this park for years to come.
