It is possible that Isanti County will award the snowplowing contract to more than one contractor. All contractors must show evidence that their equipment is in good working order.

The County also reserves the right in its sole judgment to:

- c) Request clarifications of the proposals submitted.

STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

- 1) Contractor acknowledges that the contractor has been provided with an opportunity to view and inspect the premises where the contractor will be working. The contractor accepts premises in its present condition.
- 2) Contractor agrees that it shall be responsible for any injury or loss to any agent, employee, or subcontractor of the contractor or any other person present upon the premises at the direction of the contractor or its agent.
- 3) The contractor agrees that it shall indemnify and hold harmless the County of Isanti from any liability claim, lawsuit, or any act or failure to act by the contractor or its agent, employee, subcontractor, or other persons acting at the direction of the contractor arising out of the services provided in this contract.
- 4) Contractor agrees that he/she shall indemnify and hold harmless the County of Isanti from any liability claim, law suit, or demand for any loss or injury of whatever sort or cause to any officer, agent, employee, or subcontractor of the contractor or any person present on the premises at the request of the contractor or its officer, agent, employee, or subcontractor.
- 5) All contractors must submit, along with the Snow Removal Specifications Form, a Certificate of Insurance (approved by the Isanti County Attorney as being sufficient) and commercial excess policy. This includes comprehensive premises operations, products/completed operations, contractual, independent contractors, property, and personal injury.
