## FAMILY & GROUP FAMILY CHILD CARE

### AGE GROUP DEFINITIONS (MINNESOTA STATUTES 245A.02, subd. 19)

- "**Newborn**" means a child between birth and six weeks old.
- "**Infant**" means a child who is at least six weeks old but less than 12 months old.
- "**Toddler**" means a child who is at least 12 months old but less than 24 months old for family and group family child care (Class A and C 1, C 2, C 3). For specialized infant and toddler family and specialized group family child care (Class B 1, B 2 and D) a toddler means a child who is at least 12 months old but less than 30 months old.

C1	12 mo to <24 mo
C2	12 mo to <24 mo
C3	12 mo to <24 mo
D	12 mo to <30 mo
B1	12 mo to <30 mo

- "**Preschooler**" means a child who is at least 24 months old up to school age.
- "**School age**" means a child who is at least five years of age, but is younger than 11 years of age.
