

ISANTI COUNTY SHERIFF - WATER PATROL

TEMPORARY STRUCTURE PERMIT REGULATIONS

FOR

MOORING BUOYS

Each year you will be required to reapply.

1. The permit number must be displayed in 2 inch numerals on the upper half of the buoy.
2. The buoy must be white in color and encircled by a 3 inch blue band.
3. The buoy must extend at least 8 inches above the water line and be no greater than 20 inches in length.
4. The buoy must have at least 15 square inches above the water line and be no greater than 20 inches in width.
5. The buoy area must not exceed 100 feet from shore, including the swing of the boat moored to it. During low water seasons, the Sheriff's Water Patrol may grant temporary extensions beyond 100 feet while the low water exists. The mooring will be required to be moved back within 100 feet from shore when the water table allows. The swing of the boat moored shall not cross the projected property line of adjoining neighbors without their written permission.
6. It must not be a navigational hazard or impair other recreational uses.
7. Each year on or before the 1st of November the buoy must be removed so as not to create a hazard for winter recreation or the buoy portion must be put under the surface of the ice.
8. If you move your buoy at any time from its original location you must inform the Sheriff's Water Patrol.
9. Water depth at your mooring site should not exceed one and one half more than your watercraft draft.
10. Any object used for anchoring your mooring buoy must be clean and nonpolluting. All anchoring must be retrievable from the lake. Engine blocks will not be used for anchoring buoys.
